Subject of Review:	The environmental benefits of the USDA Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) depend upon both the environmental sensitivity of land enrolled and the conservation covers selected for that land. The CRP's General Signup, which enrolls the majority of program acreage, uses a mix of competitive pressure from the auction format and an added incentive of cost share payment to encourage higher quality conservation covers. In this report, we examine recent General Signup offer data and new data on cost share payments to look at which cover practices CRP participants most commonly choose, how much those practices cost both the program participants and USDA, and how much participants respond to cover practice cost and ranking points when making their choices about cover practices. We use these empirical results, coupled with a simple theoretical model to project the implications of policy changes that would adjust the ranking or financial incentives to select higher quality conservation covers.
