Subject of Review:	The African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) will soon be the largest free trade area in the world once fully operational (in terms of the number of countries)—connecting 1.3 billion people across 55 countries with a combined gross domestic product (GDP) valued at \$3.4 trillion. The free trade area could, particularly, impact African agricultural trade as growth in their economies could increase the demand for processed agricultural products—offering expanding opportunities for U.S. agricultural trade and investments in the region. This report examines past and emerging trends in Africa's agricultural trade to discuss sources and destinations and investigates what it may mean for future U.S. investments and trade in the region. Particular attention is given to assessing changing patterns of agricultural trade from within and outside the continent, including within existing free trade areas.
