Subject of Review:	ject of Review: The administration of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) has been largely uniform across States since the early 1970s. However, with passage of welfare reform in 1996, as well as subsequent legislative and regulatory changes, States now have increased discretion in how they administer the program. States have adopted policies that affect income and asset eligibility standards for SNAP benefits, transaction costs associated with enrolling and maintaining benefits, stigma associated with participating in the program, and outreach efforts to raise awareness of SNAP and promote the benefits of program participation. This study creates a SNAP policy index that provides an easily digestible metric that captures differences in implementation of State-level SNAP policy options, using data from ERS's SNAP Policy Database.
