Subject of Review:	Foodborne illness linked to contaminated produce is a public health concern. The Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA), signed into law in 2011, is the most recent step in efforts to reduce the risk of microbial contamination that can cause human illness. While the law includes many provisions, the "Standards for Growing, Harvesting, Packing, and Holding of Produce for Human Consumption," commonly known as the Produce Rule (PR), is the most important for farm-level produce operations. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) released the PR in 2015, which went into effect in January 2017 with phased-in implementation beginning in January 2018 (U.S. Food and Drug Administration, 2015a). This report focuses on the role of retailers in the development and implementation of food safety programs across the supply chain.
