Subject of Review:	The H-2A guest worker program allows U.S. agricultural employers to hire foreign workers on a temporary or seasonal basis. Many U.S. producers of labor-intensive commodities are adjusting to tighter farm labor markets by employing H-2A workers. The program has rapidly expanded over the last decade with the total number of H-2A certifications increasing from 79,000 in 2010 to 257,000 in 2019. This report explores how H-2A usage levels differ by agricultural sector, across geography, and by the type of firm requesting the workers. The analyses in this study can provide a benchmark for future changes in H-2A labor trends resulting from disruptions induced by the COVID-19 pandemic.
