Subject of Review:	Animal manure provides crop nutrients and soil regenerative properties, but its low nutrient density reduces its market value as a fertilizer. With further processing, manure can be used to generate energy in the forms of heat, gas and electricity, but innovation is required to compete against other renewable energy sources. Mismanaged manure can contribute to air and water quality problems. Environmental regulations can both raise manure management costs and increase manure's value as an energy precursor. This study uses data from the USDA Agricultural Resource Management Survey to describe current manure production, handling, storage and use. An extensive literature review of manure-related research describes emerging and existing technologies that have the potential to increase the value of manure or reduce manure management costs. The study identifies potential Federal programs and policies for promoting adoption of technologies that enhance manure value for farmers.
