Subject of Review:	USDA's working lands programs, which incentivize farmers to adopt conservation practices, are built on the concept of resource concerns. Some resource concerns are related to public environmental benefits such as down-stream water quality. Other resource concerns are related to on-field private benefits, such as soil quality and weed pressure. Many on-field resource concerns, such as soil erosion, are closely related to off-field public benefits. While a great deal of data is available on some concerns (such as soil erodibility), national assessments of many resource concerns (such as soil compaction) are largely unavailable. To fill this assessment gap, USDA collected information on self-assessment of on-field resource concerns using field-level data of several major commodity crops from the Agricultural Resource Management Survey.
