Subject of Review: About 2 percent of the 2 million U.S. farms are classified as nonfamily farms and on average represent over 13 percent of all U.S. farmgate value of production. While nonfamily farms are responsible for a disproportionately high amount of agricultural production, only a small fraction of nonfamily operations are large, and there is a wide range of operation types, spanning different sales classes, management types, and household situations. Previous farm household research based on the Agricultural Resource Management Survey (ARMS) data, including the Farm Household Income Forecast and Farm Household Income Estimates, have omitted households operating nonfamily farms, even though household level data is collected for these operations and could be reported. Principal operators of nonfamily farms are important decisionmakers and stakeholders in the agricultural and rural economies regardless of the familial ownership structure of their operation. The well-being of nonfamily farm principal operator households has critical implications for agricultural sector entry and exit – not only in ownership, but as a profession.
