Preliminary Title: Utilizing the USDA's National Household Food Acquisition and Purchase Survey to Calculate a Household Level Food Environment Measure

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Subject of Review: Many commonly used food retail environment measures are geography based, which limits their accuracy and usefulness in multiple ways. Utilizing the IRI Retail Panel, Purchase to Plate Tool, and the National Food Acquisition and Purchase Survey we develop and calculate a household level Food Retail Environment Quality measure to address these limitations. The measure approximates a household's exposure to a healthy food retail space, discounting the weight of a store by its distance, for each store within a 20-mile radius. Through this process we are able to calculate the Food Retail Environment Quality measure for respondents of the National Food Acquisition and Purchase Survey. When compared to a more traditional food access measure--a county-level low-income low-access measure--the new measure allows for greater household heterogeneity and provides opportunities to extend analysis on the impact of the food retail environment. Specifically, the measure can be used to investigate the influence of the food retail environment for households that reside in the lowest quality food retail environments, rather than the average household in an area. In addition, household level variation in the measure allows for econometric techniques, such as fixed effects, to be more readily applied.
