Subject of Review: Food prices can impact Americans' ability to make healthy food choices. Food price changes have the potential to affect affordability, food security, and diet quality, but price changes may not occur uniformly across the country or across all types of foods. Reliable data about the food price landscape are an important tool for economic research on Americans' food choices and access to healthy and affordable food. However, the understanding of these relationships is limited by the availability of granular public data on food prices. Food prices vary by geographic area, by store type, and over time. National- or annual-level aggregate price data can mask the extent to which price variation across these dimensions affects consumer purchasing decisions.

Purpose of Review: The purpose of the review is to ensure the high-quality of the economic analysis, transparent explanation of methods, objective interpretation of results, and effective communication to the intended audience.
