Subject of Review: Salmonellosis from chicken is a major public health concern, causing 25 percent of the 1.35 4 million illnesses due to salmonellosis in 2021, according to the Food Safety Inspection Service (FSIS). 1 5 In 2021, FSIS launched a Healthy People 2030 target to reduce Salmonella infections from chicken by 25-percent by 2030.2 6 One initiative enacted to help reach Healthy People 2030 7 salmonellosis targets is a determination that not ready-to-eat (NRTE) breaded stuffed chicken products that contain high levels of Salmonella are adulterated.3 8 Another recently proposed 9 initiative would (1) declare highly virulent types of Salmonella as adulterants, (2) phase out 10 performance standards, categories, and disclosure of categories for poultry products, and (3) 11 require establishments to implement a microbial monitoring program.
