Subject of Review:	Cooperative Extension is an increasingly state-led activity. USDA funding level for Cooperative Extension at Land grant colleges and universities fell by about 60 percent in real terms from their peak in the 1970s. USDA funding for Cooperative Extension at land grant colleges and universities fell by about 60 percent in real terms from their peak in the 1970s. The Federal share of total Cooperative Extension funding also declined; Land grant universities have diversified their funding sources, supplementing federal funding with the resources from state and county governments and non- governmental grants and user fees. Although Land Grant Universities no longer report the full extent of their extension programs to the USDA, it appears that nationwide, full-time equivalent (FTE) extension staff may have fallen by about 30 percent since its maximum in 1979. Extension activity has become more diversified, with a reduced focus on agriculture. There are also significant differences in program priorities among states and regions.
