Subject of Review: The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has been monitoring the extent and severity of household food security in the United States for more than 25 years. USDA's Economic Research Service (ERS) sponsors the annual, nationally representative Food Security Supplement to the Current Population Survey. The Food Security Supplement data are collected by the U.S. Census Bureau and ERS analyzes the data to produce the annual report "Household Food Security in the United States." Food-secure households have consistent, dependable access to enough food for active, healthy living. Food-insecure households had difficulty at some time during the year providing enough food for all their members because of a lack of resources.
