Subject of Review: Poultry is the most traded livestock commodity in the world by volume. Rising demand for poultry due to increasing income and changing dietary preferences, especially in emerging markets, is expected to persist over the next decade. However, international trade in poultry is subject to high levels of tariffs, especially tariff-rate quotas (TRQs) and different types of non tariff measures (NTMs). Analyses of the effects of different types of these trade barriers on poultry trade are scarce, primarily due to data limitations as well as the nondiscriminatory application of many poultry NTMs which make econometric analysis difficult. Given the increasing importance of poultry trade, there is growing interest in understanding the application of nondiscriminatory NTMs on poultry trade over time and how different types of NTMs may affect trade values.
