Subject of Review: The authors use data from the USDA's 2012-13 National Household and Food Acquisition and Purchase Survey (FoodAPS) to develop a methodology for imputing missing quantities for item level data, compare the overall nutritional quality of 7 days of household-level acquisitions to 2 days of individual-level dietary intakes as reported in the 2011-12 National Health and Nutritional Examination Survey, and describe the method used to classify food items into the ERS Food Groups developed for FoodAPS.
