Subject of Review: The production of goods and services throughout an economy requires the use of materials and resources and interactions with other economic sectors. Linking natural resources to economic activity is difficult because of the varying dimensions in the different datasets, such as geography, activity scale, or time. This work builds upon previous research at ERS that either focused on several resources in one time period or one resource over several time periods. In this technical bulletin, we document how we build out a resources module and present a flexible accounting structure to measure resource use throughout the economy. We focus on both natural (energy, freshwater) and human resources (labor), but the coverage could be expanded to other materials and resources following a similar methodology. These data are informative on their own, but also provide opportunities for macroeconomic modeling.
