Subject of Review: Agriculture is one sector where China's imports boomed after it joined the World Trade Organization (WTO) in 2001. Increased agricultural exports to China benefited farmers in the United States and other countries. Still, trading partners have questioned China's implementation of its commitments to open its agricultural market. This report examines China's role in world agricultural trade during its first two decades as a WTO Member, evaluates the importance of sales to China for U.S. farmers, discusses China's implementation of its WTO commitments, and summarizes China's international agricultural trade policy.
