Preliminary Title: Higher Prices for Beef, Pork, Poultry, and Other Meats Reduced Consumer Welfare During Covid-19 Pandemic

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Subject of Review: The U.S. food system is generally regarded as both efficient and productive, but the Covid-19 pandemic hampered its normal operations and revealed the limits of its resiliency. Among other things, U.S. households faced sharply higher food prices for many staple items including meats. In this study, we examine and compare U.S. households' meat purchases in 2020 during the Covid-19 pandemic with those in 2019 before the outbreak of the virus. A demand system for households' purchases of beef, pork, poultry, and other meats is estimated to better understand their responses to the higher prices as well as to estimate the impact that higher prices had on households' well-being.
