ERS's Major Land Uses (MLU) series is the only inventory of all major uses of public and private land in all 50 States. Since 1945, these estimates have been published at roughly 5-year intervals, coinciding with the Census of Agriculture. This study presents the results of the latest inventory (2017) of U.S. major land uses and examines national and regional trends in land use over time.
