Subject of Review: In this report, we use data from the 2018 and 2020 Status of Forces Survey of Active Duty Members and the Current Population Survey Food Security Supplement to compare food insecurity among the U.S. military and civilian populations. To facilitate this comparison, we constructed a comparison group of civilian adults, who are employed full time, that are observationally similar to active duty service members based on their gender, age, race and ethnicity, marital status, presence of at least one child, educational attainment, and geographic region of residence.
